NEW YORK/ACROSS THE ATLANTIC

LISBON

WEDNESDAY, MAY 3

This morning you visit Jeronimos Monastery, a Manueline Renaissance masterpiece, where Vasco da Gama is buried. See the Tower of Belem, Castelo Sao Jorge, the Alfama district, the cobble-stoned streets of the Old Bairro Alto, the Lower Town (Baixa), the Praca do Rossio, arcaded buildings and

fountains, and the tropical Estela gardens. This afternoon is free for shopping. Specialties include ceramics, rugs, thick hand knit fisherman sweaters and cork products. (B)

LISBON/SANTARÉM/FATIMA AREA

THURSDAY, MAY 4

After breakfast depart for Santarém, known as Portugal's bullfighting capital and one of Portugal's most visited pilgrimage sites. See the 17th century Jesuit seminary that now serves as the town's cathedral with gilded carved altars. Visit the 14th century Santissimo Milagre Church, which houses the famed Eucharistic Miracle of Santarém. Continue to Fatima to begin your *celebration of the 100th Anniversary of the Fatima Apparitions*. Visit the Basilica of Our Lady of Fatima, the tombs of Francisco, Jacinto and Sr. Lucia, the Aljustrel where the children lived and the Valinhos, where Our Lady appeared after the children's return from prison. Also visit the Little Chapel of Apparitions with the famous statue of "Our Lady of Fatima." (B,D)

Continue the celebration of the 100th Anniversary of the Apparitions of Our Lady with Mass and full day in Fatima for prayer and devotion. This evening attend the Candlelight Procession, if available. (B,D)

**FATIMA/COIMBRA/BRAGA/
SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA**

SATURDAY, MAY 6

Depart today for Santiago de Compostela, famed pilgrimage center since the Middle Ages and Spain's holiest city. As you drive through the Portuguese countryside, you will see the holy cities of Coimbra and Braga. Coimbra is the site of the Monastery of St. Clare, which is the resting place of Queen Santa Isabel, patron saint of Portugal. In Braga, see the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception of Portugal on Mt. Sameiro and the Shrine of the "Good Jesus," referred to as Bom Jesus do Monte, on Mt. Espinho. This evening enjoy dinner at a local restaurant featuring typical Spanish cuisine. **(B,D)**

SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

SUNDAY, MAY 7

This morning attend Mass and then begin your tour of Santiago de Compostela, the capital city of Galicia, which will include the magnificent 12th century Romanesque and Baroque cathedral housing the remains of St. James, patron saint of Spain. You will also see the various buildings of the University, one of Europe's oldest. The balance of the day in this historic city is at leisure. **(B)**

With magnificent gilt wood carvings, it appears to be bathed in gold. Tour the interior of the capacious Stock Exchange Palace with its grand Hall of Nations and the golden Arabian Hall. PORTO/SINTRA/LISBON

Head south to the picturesque town of Sintra. Here you will visit the royal Pena Palace. This 19th century Romanticism styled building is now deemed a UNESCO World Heritage site.
